**ROAD SAFETY AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS IN SCHOOLS IN VICINITY OF
PROJECT ROADS**

The Republic of Serbia has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Road Rehabilitation and Safety Project (the Project) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The objective of the consulting services (“the Services”) is implementation of the children safety awareness campaign aiming to provide training and necessary skills to the school’s teachers from 1st to 4th classes in elementary schools nearby rehabilitated RRSP road sections (Training of Teachers – ToT). Expected result is increased traffic safety knowledge of pupils and improved behavior in traffic.

The requirements for the Services are fully identified in the Terms of Reference, which will be provided to the selected firm, but in general considers implementation of children safety awareness campaign aiming to provide training to school’s teachers from 1st to 4th classes. Trained school teachers will teach the children in minimum 20 selected elementary schools in 4 regional centers under the RRSP. Contract duration will be approximately 12 months.

The services will cover but shall not be limited to the following:

- Review of official, Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development, traffic safety curriculum for elementary schools with proposed improvements if any;
- Review of available traffic safety children's books in usage with proposals of improvements;
- Preparation of all necessary training materials (e.g. all teachers training materials - scripts, materials for children usage and children's knowledge and behavior tests, including of evaluation forms, video and audio recordings from training, etc.);
- Perform of train the trainer service (improvement of teacher’s traffic safety knowledge and skills). Consultant shall propose content of theoretical (lessons which will be provided) and practical (work in real traffic conditions) part of trainings
- Organization of teacher’s transport from their schools to the centre where training will be organized and food coverage;
- Follow up of trained teachers. Consultant shall propose method for follow up of teachers work after finalization of service, e.g. survey of trained pupils in schedule period of time after service is finished, etc.

- Consultant shall propose some materials that will be delivered to each pupil involved in process of education. Also some kind of reward for best classes shall be proposed.

While performing the Services, the Consultant will comply with provisions of:

- existing laws in Republic of Serbia, accompanied by-law documents and official guidelines/rulebooks concerning children's traffic education,
- best international practice concerning children's traffic safety education, and
- Terms of Reference.

The Public Enterprise “Roads of Serbia (the Client) now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlist will be based on information provided on the firm’s profile (organization and capabilities); specific experience of the firm, relevant to the assignment or of similar nature and experience under similar conditions in the last five years.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank’s [Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants \[under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants\] by World Bank Borrowers](#) dated January 2011, (“Consultant Guidelines”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a subconsultancy to enhance their qualifications.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the CQS (Selection Based on the Consultants’ Qualifications) method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.
