INVITATION FOR TENDERS

This Invitation for Tenders follows the General Procurement Notice update (7705-GPN-44750) for this project which was published in *Procurement Opportunities* on the EBRD website: 24/09/2014.

The Public Enterprise "Roads of Serbia" hereinafter referred to as the Employer, intends using part of the proceeds of a loan from the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (the Bank) towards the cost of Road Rehabilitation and Safety Project.

The Employer now invites sealed tenders from contractors for the following contract to be funded from part of the proceeds of the loan:

- **Urgent Maintenance and Remedy of Damages on the State Road IIA 152 Topola 1 – Bućin Grob, Section: Topola 1 – Bućin Grob, from km 0+000 to km 27+280, L=27.280 km, Contract Ref. No. RRSP/EW-II152TBG/2014-05.**

The Contractor is expected to develop a main design for urgent maintenance of road section and the main design/designs for remedy of damages on structures and landslides approved by the Technical Committee as required by the Law, to provide construction permit and to execute all works defined by the approved main designs and accepted by the Employer.

The civil works will consist of (but shall not be limited to) the following:

- Preliminary works which include removal of excessive vegetative material and waste, demolition of road elements on access roads (curbs and pavement), demolition and removal of elements of the damaged constructions, surface preparation of the existing pavement for application of new layers (milling of the existing pavement, repair of wide cracks, construction of leveling layers);
- Substructure works which include excavation of ditches, construction of stabilized shoulders, topsoiling of shoulders and other surfaces, and earth works on construction of asphalt access roads and bus stops;
- Superstructure works which include pavement construction on access roads; works on improvement of pavement (construction of bituminous bearing course, and construction of wearing asphalt concrete course), as well as placement of concrete curbs and construction of gutters;
- Works on structures (bridges) which include milling of the existing asphalt layer, construction or replacement of waterproofing, construction of asphalt layers (leveling course if needed, wearing course, asphalt layer on sidewalk), demolition and reconstruction of the curbs, repair or replacement of the bearing paths, repair or replacement of the expansion devices, repair of the protective layers, bridge drainage, repair of fences and guardrails, regulation of hydraulic watercourse profile in the bridge area;
- Works on remedy of the landslides;
- Works on drainage system improvement which include cleaning and repair of elements of the existing culverts, culverts extension, construction of the new culverts in accordance with the Main Design, construction of drainage pipes, construction of concrete channel, construction of concrete pipes on access roads and approaches;
- Works on protection of slopes and on remedy of damaged slopes and embankments in accordance with the designed solution which include arrangement of geometry of embankment and shoulders, construction of protective meshes, remedy of landslides, construction of retaining walls and gabions and torrent arrangement in the road area;
- Roadside arrangement and placement of traffic signalization and road furniture.

The Works will be performed **under traffic** with a strong emphasis on maintaining safe conditions for both the flow of traffic and the works in progress.

Time for completion of Works is **12 months**.

Tendering for contracts to be financed with the proceeds of a loan from the Bank is open to firms from any country. The proceeds of the Bank's loan will not be used for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations.

To be qualified for the award of a contract, tenderers must satisfy the following requirements:

Financial requirements

- Submission of audited balance sheets or if not required by the law of the Tenderer's country, other financial statements acceptable to the Employer, for the last **five (5) years** to demonstrate the current soundness of the Tenderers financial position and its prospective long term profitability;
- Minimum average annual turnover of **EUR 14,700,000 (fourteen million seven hundred thousand EUR) equivalent**, calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last **five (5) years**;
- The Tenderer must demonstrate access to, or availability of, financial resources such as liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit, and other financial means, other than any contractual advance payments to meet: (i) the following cash-flow requirement: **min. EUR 3,200,000 (three million two hundred thousand EUR) equivalent**, and (ii) the overall cash flow requirements for this contract and its concurrent commitments.

Experience requirements

- General experience – Experience under contracts in the role of contractor or management contractor for the last **five (5) years** prior to the tender submission deadline, and with activity in at least nine (9) months in each year.
- Specific experience:
 - (a) Participation as contractor, management contractor, or subcontractor, in at least **two (2) contracts** within the last **five (5) years**, in total value of at least **EUR 9.8 mil. (nine million eight hundred thousand EUR)** where the minimum value of the contract must be at least **EUR 3.9 mil. (three million nine hundred thousand EUR)**, that have been successfully and substantially completed and that are similar to the proposed Works. The similarity shall be based on the physical size, complexity, methods/technology or other characteristics as described in Section VI, Employer's Requirements;
 - (b) For the above or other contracts executed during the period stipulated in (a) above, a minimum experience in the following key activities: completed works on remedy of at least 1 landslide; 15,000 tons of asphalt mixtures (BNS and AB) at least in one month placed in road paving.

Above and all other qualification requirements related to the eligibility, litigation history, and technical capabilities are specified in the Section III. Evaluation and Qualification Criteria of the Tender Documents.
