INVITATION FOR TENDERS

**LOT 6 Construction of noise barriers on E-75 motorway section from
"Transped" Interchange to Vrcin**

This Invitation for Tenders follows the General Procurement Notice for this project which was published on the EBRD website, Procurement Notices (www.ebrd.com) on 20th March 2014 and updated on 25 May 2015.

The Public Enterprise "Roads of Serbia", hereinafter referred to as "the Employer", intends using part of the proceeds of a loan from the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (the Bank) towards the cost of LOT 6, of the Belgrade Highway and Bypass Project.

The Employer now invites sealed tenders from contractors for the single contract to be funded with the proceeds of a loan. Therefore, based on article 7, paragraph 1, item 2, sub-item (2) of Public procurement Law ("Official Gazette RS" no.124/12) for selection of the successful tenderer the Bank special procurement procedures will be applied:

○ **Proposed works include:**

Works on construction of Noise Barriers: A five (5) noise protection walls in total length of 2.64 km should be constructed on subject highway section. One noise protection wall should be constructed by using reflective panels (absorption <4dB), while the other walls must be absorbing (absorption > 4 dB). On particular parts of all five noise protection walls a transparent noise protection elements are envisaged too. The structural system is console type. The underground part of the structure consists of reinforced concrete piles Ø600mm, pilling technology - rebuttal, drilling or installation of precast piles. The piles provide structural stability and represent a clamp for above-ground part of the structure which is made of steel, "HEA" profile of different type (HEA160, HEA180, and HEA200).

Traffic equipment: A guardrails are envisaged in front of the noise protection walls: H1W4 on the shoulder of the highway, H2W3 on the retaining wall and H2W4 on the shoulder of the highway, in the zone before and after the guardrail type H2W3. Guardrails should have reflective road studs (catadiopeters).

Drainage works: On highway sections where noise protection walls are placed on embankment, a drainage system consist the drainage outfalls. The drainage outlets are placed on every third field or at a distance of 9 meters in order to avoid delays in evacuating water from the slope.

- **Time for completion:** 150 calendar days
- **To be qualified for the award the contract, tenderers (sole tenderer or joint venture/consortia (JVCA)) must satisfy the following minimum criteria:**

Financial requirements

- Submission of audited balance sheets or if not required by the law of the Tenderer's country, other financial statements acceptable to the Employer, for **the last three (3) years** to demonstrate the current soundness of the Tenderers financial position and its prospective long term profitability.
- The Tenderer must have a Minimum average annual turnover of **EUR 3,500,000 (three million five hundred thousand EUR) equivalent**, calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the **last three (3) years**. (2012, 2013, 2014). Each partner of JVCA must meet the minimum of 25% of the requirement and at least one partner must meet the minimum of 40% of the requirement.
- The Tenderer must demonstrate access to, or availability of, financial resources such as liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit, and other financial means, other than any contractual advance payments to meet the following cash-flow requirement: **minimum EUR 1,300,000 (one million three hundred thousand EUR) equivalent** and the overall cash flow requirements for this contract and its current commitments. Each partner of JVCA must meet the minimum of 25% of the requirement and at least one partner must meet the minimum of 40% of the requirement.

Experience requirements

- General experience: Experience under contracts in the role of contractor or management contractor for the **last five (5) years** prior to the tender submission deadline, and with activity in at least nine (9) months in each year.
- Specific experience:
 - a. The Tenderer must have Relevant experience as sole contractor or partner in JVCA in **at least one (1) contract - noise barriers construction** that is completed after 1st January 2005, where minimum value of the contractor's share per contract must be at least **EUR 1.0 mill. (one million EUR)**.
 - b. The Tenderer must have, for the above or other contracts executed during the period stipulated in (a) above, a minimum experience in the following key activities: **constructed noise barriers in total length of minimum 5 km**.

Above and all other qualification requirements related to the eligibility, litigation history, personal and technical capabilities are specified in the Section III Evaluation and Qualification Criteria of the Tender Documents.

Tendering for contracts to be financed with the proceeds of a loan from the Bank is open to tenderers from any country. The proceeds of the Bank's loan will not be used for payments to persons or entities or for any import of goods if such payment or import is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations.
