**INVITATION FOR BIDS (IFB)**

**REHABILITATION OF THE HIGHWAY IA (E-75)  
SECTION: NOVI SAD -BELGRADE (RIGHT CARRIAGEWAY)  
FROM KM 111+700 TO KM 117+200, L=5.5 KM**

**CONTRACT ID NO. RRSP/RRW-E75BNS/2015-18**

1. The Republic of Serbia has received financing from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development toward the cost of the Road Rehabilitation Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Rehabilitation of the highway IA (E-75), Section: Novi Sad -Belgrade (right carriageway), from km 111+700 to km 117+200, L=5.5 km, Contract ID No. RRSP/RRW-E75BNS/2015-18. This contract will be jointly financed by the the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development, European Investment Bank and Republic of Serbia. Bidding process will be governed by the World Bank's rules and procedures.
2. The Public Enterprise "Roads of Serbia" (hereinafter referred to the Employer) invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the rehabilitation works consisting of the following:
  - Preliminary works which include: setting out, removal of existing kerbs, removal of existing gutters, demolishing of existing pavement, milling of asphalt layer, repair of pavement damages (cracks and ruts);
  - Earth works which include: excavation of top soil on shoulders, bulk excavation, road base preparation, subsoil treatment on shoulders, topsoiling on shoulders;
  - Drainage works which include: placing of elevated kerbs 18/24, asphalt gutters construction, placing of pre-cast channels;
  - Asphalt pavement works which include: construction of sub-base from crushed stone aggregate 0/63mm, construction of sub-base from crushed stone aggregate 0/31mm, bituminuos base course BNS 22s A, asphalt concrete - wearing course AB 16s;
  - Traffic signs and road furniture works which include: road markings – continuous and intermittent lines, road furniture works – placing of lighting signs on road and crash barrier.

The Works will be performed under traffic with a strong emphasis on maintaining safe conditions for both the flow of traffic and works in progress.

The construction period is 90 days.

The Bidder should meet the following qualification criteria and capabilities:

Financial requirements

- Submission of the audited balance sheets or, if not required by the laws of the Bidder's country, other financial statements acceptable to the Employer, for the last five (5) years to demonstrate the current soundness of the Bidder's financial position and its prospective long-term profitability. In the case of JV, each partner must meet requirement.
- Minimum average annual construction turnover of RSD 2.6 billion, calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress and/or completed within the last five (5) years. In the case of JV, JV must meet requirement, Lead partner must meet forty percent (40%) of the requirement, and all other partners must meet twenty five percent (25%) of the requirement.
- The Bidder must demonstrate access to, or availability of financial resources such as liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit, and other financial means other than any contractual advance payments to meet the following cash flow requirements: min. RSD 440 million. In the case of JV, all parties combined must meet requirement.

Experience requirements

- General experience – Experience under construction contracts in the role of prime contractor, JV member, sub-contractor, or management contractor for at least the last five (5) years, starting 1st January 2011. In the case of JV, each partner must meet requirement.
- Specific experience:
  - Participation as prime contractor, joint venture member, management contractor or sub-contractor, in at least two (2) contracts between 1st January 2011 and application submission deadline each with a value of the contractor's share per contract at least RSD 260 million that have been successfully and substantially completed and that are similar to the proposed Works - – motorway or semi-motorway or double carriage road with asphalt concrete pavement construction /reconstruction /rehabilitation . In the case of JV, all parties combined must meet requirement.
  - For the above and any other contracts completed and under implementation as prime contractor, joint venture member, management contractor or sub-contractor during the period between 1st January 2011 and application submission deadline, a minimum construction experience in the following key activities successfully completed: 12,000 tons of asphalt mixtures (BNS and AB) at least in one month placed in road paving. In the case of JV, one member must meet requirements.

Above and all other qualification requirements related to the eligibility, litigation history, and technical capabilities are specified in the Section III. Evaluation and Qualification Criteria of the Bidding Documents.

3. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, issued in January 2011 ("Procurement

Guidelines”), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.
