Minister Momirović: "Gratitude to road workers for their best efforts and continuous work"

Minister of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure, Mr. Tomislav Momirović, together with the Acting Director, Mr. Zoran Drobniak, the Executive Director of the Sector for Maintenance of I and II Category state road and Manager of the Winter Service Headquarters, Mr. Zoran Stojisavljević, and other associates, visited the road maintenance depot located in Vrčin on January 11, 2021.

„I am grateful to road workers for their continuous work even through the holidays, and snowfalls, ensuring that all road routes in Serbia are passable“, the Minister Momirović said, and appealed to drivers, especially those driving the heavy goods vehicles, not to start their journey without appropriate winter equipment.

Minister Momirović emphasized that the PE „Roads of Serbia“ provides its help even in winter maintenance of local roads: „There are 15,700



kilometers of roads under our maintenance operations, and besides that we actively support local self-governments, but naturally after cleaning our priority road routes so as to ensure safe traffic flow in the Republic of Serbia.“

The Acting Director, Mr. Zoran Drobniak, and the Executive Director of the Sector for Maintenance of I and II Category state road and Manager of the Winter Service Headquarters, Mr. Zoran Stojisavljević, said that the road companies are ready for every challenge in terms of winter road maintenance, and that they have at their disposal sufficient quantities of salt, crushed stone aggregate and gritting material, as well as cold mix asphalt for pot holes repair.

Issue of the Illegal Settlement at Belgrade Bypass is Solved

The Minister of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure of Serbia, Mr. Tomislav Momirović, Acting Director of Public Enterprise "Roads of Serbia", Mr. Zoran Drobniak, and Acting Director of the „Koridori Srbije“, Mr. Aleksandar Antić, visited on January 11, 2021, the construction site on the section of Belgrade By-

pass at Resnik, where an illegal settlement „Vi-jadukt“ is located.

„A problem related to resettlement of 74 families which has lasted for several decades is now solved through careful communication during two months of negotiations which also involved the Institution of the Protector of Citzens of the Republic of Serbia. We wanted to help our citizens and to please them all“, said Minister Momirović, and thanked to Directors Drobniak and Antić for their help provided in course of solving this issue.

Inhabitants of the illegal settlement „Vi-jadukt“ were paid the indemnity for houses which are going to be demolished for the purpose of construction of the Belgrade Bypass, and money granted to them shall be sufficient for resolving their housing problems.

The Minister Momirović invited all the contractors engaged in construction of the Belgrade Bypass to work hard every day in order to finish the works on Belgrade Bypass and thus relief traffic pressure in the City and reduce pollution. The Contractors' representatives, Chinese Company „Power China and Azerbaijani „Azvirt“ have promised that the works on section from Ostružnica to Ibar Highway, including the Interchange „Petlovo brdo“, will be completed even before April 2021, which is a scheduled deadline.





Minister Tomislav Momirović visiting PE “Roads of Serbia”

On 11th January, 2021, the Minister of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure, Tomislav Momirović, visited the PE “Roads of Serbia”, where he talked with the Acting Director Zoran Drobnjak, the Assistant Director Slavoljub Tubić, the Technical Director Slobodan Basurić and the executive directors of all the sectors in the enterprise.

The executives of the enterprise have presented to him the work and the activities of the PE “Roads of Serbia” and informed him on the most significant projects within all sectors.

The Minister has thanked for the good-quality collaboration and praised the work of the enterprise: “The road network is one of the biggest capital values in the Republic of Serbia, whose territory features almost 17,000 km of I and II category state roads and it is a great pleasure to be the minister in a sector with a company like this one, one of the most important ones in the country.

Minister Momirović has announced a year marked by various important infrastructure projects, the completion of the commenced and the construction of new motorways and expressways throughout Serbia, in which 210.8 billion dinars will be invested.





Minister Tomislav Momirović Controlled the Works on the Motorway Preljina - Požega

The Minister of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure, Tomislav Momirović, the Acting Director Zoran Drobniak, and the Assistant Director Slavoljub Tubić, visited on November 1, 2020, section of the motorway "Miloš the Great" from Preljina to Požega which is currently under construction, and where they met with the representatives of the contractor, Chinese Company "China Communication Construction Company" (CCCC).

"This is my first activity as a line minister. Political activities of the President of our Republic have really made a series of successes in the field of infrastructure, but none of the projects is so apparent as the motorway "Miloš the Great", said the Minister Momirović.

The Contractor, Company CCCC, confirmed that the entire section from Preljina to Požega, 30.93 km, will be completed until 2021. The third



of this road route comprises bridges and tunnels. Laz and Munjino brdo (Munjino Hill) will be among the longest tunnels in Serbia, almost three kilometers long.

Minister Momirović expressed his satisfaction with time schedule of works, thanked to the Chinese Company on high-quality works and to the PE "Roads of Serbia" as an Employer.

"I am certain that what we have agreed on will be performed. Our imperative is that in the next year, i.e. until the end of 2021, the works will be completed and this section will be opened to traffic. Road route from Preljina to the settlement Pakovraće is a very important segment of the section which will significantly relieve traffic pressure in Čačak", concluded the Minister Momirović.

New bridge over river Ljubovidja opened for traffic

The new bridge over the river Ljubovidja, on the section of I B category state road no. 28, Gračanica – Ljubovija, was constructed in the place of the old one and opened for traffic on 26th October, 2020.

The old bridge suffered significant damage with the flooding of the river Ljubovidja in June,

after which it was demolished and the construction of a new one was commenced.

The design and technical documentation was completed in a short period of time and the bridge was constructed, being of great importance to the inhabitants of that area.



Expressway from Kragujevac to Batočina

The last section on I B category state road no.24 from Kragujevac to Batočina, in the length of 4.5 km, was opened for traffic on 20th October, 2020, in the presence of the Acting Director of Public Enterprise "Roads of Serbia" Zoran Drobnjak, the head of the Batočina municipality, Zdravko Mladenović, representatives from the Ministry of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure and the contractors.

Acting Director Zoran Drobnjak has stressed the importance of the construction of the expressway: "With the completion of the section through Batočina, that town and Kragujevac are connected with the motorway by a modern, fast and foremost safe road, used by more than 12,000 vehicles every day."

The expressway was built on the route of the existing arterial road Kragujevac – Batočina, it is 25 km long, has two traffic lanes in each direction with a median strip between them and rep-



resents the shortest link of the city of Kragujevac and the neighbouring settlements with the motorway E-75.

"The State continues the construction of motorways and expressways with the help of the President of Serbia, Aleksandar Vučić, in order to increase the safety of all traffic participants", Drobnjak has stressed and announced new projects – a new interchange and a toll station in

Batočina, which will be "much larger and wider and closer to that town".

"The works on the widening of the toll station will commence in the spring, and designs for the construction of an expressway connecting Kragujevac with the Moravian Corridor via Mrčajevci are being prepared", said the Acting Director, Zoran Drobnjak.

Always ready for winter maintenance of state roads

PE "Roads of Serbia" started with the winter maintenance of roads on 1st of November, 2020, in accordance with the Winter Maintenance Plan for I and II category state roads in the Republic of Serbia, 2020/21.

Due to the epidemiological situation and the imposed measures for the protection of public health, the Department for Public Relations did not organize the traditional press conference, but sent to the media and put on the Enterprise's website specially created contents regarding the organization of the Winter Service operation, with the footage of the statement of the Head of Winter Service Headquarters, Zoran Stojisavljević, and the footage of the motorway maintenance yard in Dobanovci.



"All road bases and yards are equipped, the capacity control has been performed, all required materials have been stored at the yards, so we are entering the forthcoming winter season well-prepared. We continually monitor

the weather conditions and adjust the engagement level of road workers' capacity in accordance with the weather forecast", said the Executive Director and the Head of the Winter Service Headquarters.



"When I grow up, I'll be..."

Online at International Agricultural Fair



Marking of World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims

PE "Roads of Serbia" has joined the marking of the World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims, traditionally in the third week of November, under the slogan "Remember. Support. Act."

PE "Roads of Serbia", on a daily basis, draws the attention of the public to the significance of responsible behaviour in traffic, informs traffic participants on road conditions and provides maintenance and improvement of the quality of state roads for the purpose of providing better conditions for safe and pleasant driving. As a socially responsible company, it allocates considerable funding for the increase of traffic safety and education of traffic participants.

Since March 2020, through the first in a line of educational campaigns for raising drivers' awareness and increase of traffic safety – "3 Seconds, a Whole Life", the PE "Roads of Serbia" has been emphasizing the importance of safe following distance between vehicles to prevent traffic accidents.
