The New Belgrade - Surčin section opened to traffic

Section New Belgrade - Surčin, city part of highway E-763, Belgrade - South Adriatic, is officially opened to traffic on April 1, 2023 in the presence of the President of Serbia, Aleksandar Vučić. The opening was also attended by Prime Minister Ana Brnabić, Deputy Prime Minister Siniša Mali, HE Ambassador of the People's Republic of China Chen Bo, Minister of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure Goran Vesić, acting director of PE "Roads of Serbia" Zoran Drobniak and acting director of "Corridors of Serbia" Aleksandar Antić, contractors as well as representatives of the city government.

The New Belgrade - Surčin section is recognized as an object of importance for the Republic of Serbia. It represents the connection between the city of Belgrade and the highway E-763 - "Miloš Veliki", creating a functional unit of the city roads and the highway E-763, which represents the shortest connection between Belgrade and the Adriatic Sea.



The 7.9km section is designed for a speed of 80km/h and has three 3.5m wide lanes in each direction, a 5m dividing strip, 2m wide pedestrian paths and a 2.2m wide bicycle path. There

are four bridges and two overpasses on the route. The newly built section allows drivers from Vojvođanska and Dr. Ivan Ribara streets in New Belgrade to connect directly to the "Miloš Veliki"

highway, instead of the previous entry via the Belgrade - Šid highway section, which makes their access to the "Miloš Veliki" highway shorter by about ten kilometers.



The annex to the contract on the construction of the Jakovo interchange signed

Minister of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure Goran Vesić and acting director of PE "Roads of Serbia" Zoran Drobniak and director of the Chinese company "CCCC" Yang Dong signed on May 31, 2023, in the premises of the municipality of Surčin, Annex 3 to contracts on the design and construction of inflow-outflow roads on the state road I A category number 2, Belgrade - South Adriatic for the section Surčin-Obrenovac in Jakovo, at the intersection of highway E-763 with the local road Surčin-Jakovo.





First time together at the 55th International Motor Show

At the initiative of the Ministry of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure, from March 22 to March 28, 2023 at the 55th International Motor Show, for the first time at a joint stand, the Ministry of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure, the Ministry of Internal Affairs, PE "Roads of Serbia", "Corridors of Serbia", the Road Traffic Safety Agency and AMAS were presented.

During the Motor Show the representatives of the Department of Public Relations, Sector for TMIS, Sector for Strategy, Designing and Development, Sector for Toll Collection, pointed out to the visitors all the advantages and high quality of services in the field of electronic toll collection, provided quality information about electric chargers and other activities that PE "Roads of Serbia" carries out in order to improve the toll collection system and cooperation with users.

A unique platform for electronic toll collection was also promoted, which is




currently available only on the territory of the Republic of Serbia and the Republic North Macedonia, and in the next phase

it is expected that other countries of the region will join, primarily those participating in the Open Balkan project.

Visitors of the Motor Show were also informed about the main goal of conducting educational campaigns, i.e. raising awareness about the problems of traffic accidents, i.e. drawing the public's attention to the importance and possibilities of improving the level of traffic safety, as well as reducing the level of traffic accidents through the education of all road users, by showing videos of the educational campaigns of PE "Roads of Serbia" and by distributing flyers and brochures.

The Minister of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure, Goran Vesić, officially opened the 55th International Motor Show, and after the opening, he visited the Ministry's stand and all the representatives of the institutions that were presented.



Campaigns and projects aimed at increasing traffic safety

At the exhibition area of the Ministry of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure, on March 23, 2023 a media conference was held dedicated to campaigns and projects that are implemented with the aim of increasing traffic safety.

In addition to the Minister of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure Goran Vesić and the Minister of Internal Affairs Bratislav Gašić, the conference was attended by acting director of PE "Roads of Serbia" Zoran Drobnjak, acting director of

"Corridors of Serbia" Aleksandar Antić, the head of the Traffic Police Directorate, Slaviša Lakićević, the director of the Road Traffic Safety Agency Branko Stamatović, the president of the Auto Moto Association of Serbia, Dragan Stojić and the general secretary of the Auto Moto Association of Serbia, Milan Nikolić, while Dea Đurđević, Slaviša Savić and Milan Srdić spoke about traffic accidents in which they were injured.



TAG devices in PE "Post of Serbia"

During the 55th International Motor Show, in the presence of Minister Goran Vesić, on March 26, 2023 the contract on business cooperation was signed by Zoran Đorđević, acting director of PE "Post of Serbia" and Zoran Drobnjak, acting director of PE "Roads of Serbia".

After purchasing a TAG device in the branches of PE "Post of Serbia", users will register the device in a simple way through a unique web platform, which will enable them to pay tolls online with a registered payment/debit card.





Belgrade Bypass in full profile to Bubanj Potok

On Vidovdan, June 28, 2023, the section of the Belgrade Bypass, from Straževica to Bubanj Potok, with a length of 9.74 kilometers, was officially opened.

The ceremony was attended by the President of Serbia Aleksandar Vučić, Prime Minister Ana Brnabić, Deputy Prime Minister Siniša Mali, Ambassador of the People's Republic of China Chen Bo and Ambassador of the Republic of Azerbaijan Kamil Khasiyev, Minister of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure Goran Vesić, acting directors of PE "Roads of Serbia" and "Corridors of Serbia" Zoran Drobniak and Aleksandar Antić, vice president of the company "Power China International" Liu Shaoquan, mayor of Belgrade Aleksandar Šapić, representatives of contractors and other officials and guests.

After more than 30 years, it will be possible to travel from Batajnica to Bubanj Potok on the highway in full profile in a length of 47.4 kilometers and with a total of six traffic lanes.





The Belgrade Bypass connects the branch of Corridor Xb, E-75 (border with Hungary, Horgoš - Novi Sad - Belgrade) with Corridor X, E-70 (border with Croatia, Batrovci - Belgrade), state road IB category number 26 and Route 4, E-763 (Belgrade - Požega - border with Montenegro Boljare) and again part of Corridor X, E-75 (Belgrade - Niš - Preševo - border with North Macedonia).

With the completion of the Belgrade Bypass, traffic is diverted from the overloaded basic network of city roads to the Bypass, which contributes to shortening the travel time for transit flows, reducing the number of traffic accidents, the costs of vehicle exploitation, harmful gases and noise from vehicles in the inner city area.

The total length of the Bypass from Batajnica to Bubanj Potok is 47.4 km and

is designed with a calculated speed of 120 km/h.

INTERCHANGES AND JUNCTIONS:

Six interchanges are planned on the section. The situational and height solutions of the basic route have been set so that in the future it will be possible to build other interchanges if there are justified traffic reasons for this.

BRIDGES:

In the section from Dobanovci to Bubanj Potok, there are 41 bridge locations


with 79 structures. The largest bridge is over the Sava river near Ostružnica, which consists of three structures with a total length of 1,965 m (steel structures over the river and approach concrete structures on both banks). All other bridges are concrete, and five bridges stand out in terms of size: "Sveta Petka" (408 m), "Železnička reka" (406 m), "Kievski potok" (571 m), "Topčiderska dolina" (597 m) and "Bridge over the railway" (430 m).

TUNNELS:

Four tunnels were designed on the route: "Lipak" (partly under the plateau of the Ostružnica railway station, length 665 m), "Železnik" (699 m) and "Beli potok" (under Avalski put, 360 m) with two tunnel tubes, as well as tunnel "Straževica" (below Resnik, 745 m) with two separate tubes.

Ana Brnabić and Dimitar Kovačevski - with one TAG through Serbia and North Macedonia

On Sunday, July 16, 2023, the Prime Minister of the Republic of Serbia Ana Brnabić and the Prime Minister of the Republic of North Macedonia Dimitar Kovačevski in the presence of the Minister of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure Goran Vesić, the Minister of Transport and Communications of North Macedonia Blagoj Bočvarski and acting director of PE "Roads of Serbia", Zoran Drobniak, visited the Open Balkan mobile point of sale at the Preševo toll station and officially presented the start of the unified toll collection. The officials stressed the importance of the Open Balkan initiative and pointed out that this is only the first step and that the plan is to connect with other countries of the region that are interested in this project. On July 3, 2023, PE "Roads of Serbia" opened the Open Balkan mobile point of sale on the state road IA category number 1 near the Preševo toll station, where users can buy or reconfigure a TAG device, take a break and continue their journey to the Republic of North Macedonia.



Vesić and Bočvarski tested the integrated toll collection system

Minister Vesić reconfigured his TAG device at the Open Balkan mobile point of sale and visited the Romanovci toll station in North Macedonia with Minister Bočvarski, where they saw for themselves the functionality of the integrated electronic toll collection system.



Roads of Serbia and Hrvatske Autoceste signed a memorandum on business cooperation



On Thursday, July 13, 2023 in the Government of the Republic of Serbia, in the presence of the Minister of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure Goran Vesić and the Minister of Human and Minority Rights and Social Dialogue Tomislav Žigmanov, a memorandum on business cooperation was signed by PE "Roads of Serbia" and "Hrvatske Autoceste".

The memorandum was signed by acting director Zoran Drobniak on behalf of PE "Roads of Serbia", with the director of "Hrvatske Autoceste" Boris Huzjan.

By integrating the systems of the two countries, users of electronic toll collection will use one device for electronic toll collection (TAG/ENC) to travel smoothly and pay tolls in the territories of the two countries.





Expanded Stara Pazova toll station and opened to traffic

In the presence of the Minister of Construction, Transport and Infrastructure, Goran Vesić, the assistant director of PE "Roads of Serbia" Ivan Tejić, the executive director of the Sector for Toll Collection, Milenko Caković, and the assistant executive director of the Sector for Toll Collection, Darko Savić, and representatives of the contractors, on May 16, 2023 the expanded toll station Stara Pazova was opened to traffic.

The new expanded Stara Pazova toll station has 17 channels, increasing the capacity by almost 90% compared to the previous one. Designed on the model of modern toll stations, it will become one of the largest and with the Belgrade toll station it will have the highest throughput.

On July 1, 2022 the first phase of the Stara Pazova toll station expansion project was completed, 2 new traffic lanes for toll collection were put into operation, which has already significantly increased the capacity and ensured the smooth passage of vehicles during the summer season.



47x12 m with a canopy height of 6.5 m. On the island between the oversized vehicles and service traffic lanes, on the west side of the building from the direction of Novi Sad, a prefabricated substation with two transformer boxes was built, while in the extension there is a space for an aggregate plant and a power plant facility with energy cabinets and UPS devices. The far right lane is 5.5 m wide and is intended for the passage of oversized vehicles. The width of the internal roads next to the administrative and auxiliary buildings is 3 m, the same as in the parking area.

The asphalt pavement at the entrance to the main toll station has an area of 6,600 m², and at the exit 4,900 m². The area of the concrete pavement between the raised islands with tollbooths is a total of 4,900 m². A total of 11,700 m² of asphalt was installed on the plateau of the Stara Pazova toll station, with an internal road and a plateau for service facilities, and a parking space for vehicles of 930 m².

The project also provides for two parking spaces with electric chargers for users of electric vehicles, which will be marked with appropriate horizontal and vertical signage.

The project to expand toll stations in the Republic of Serbia represents another valuable investment by PE "Roads of Serbia", which will significantly contribute to the improvement of travel conditions, increase the flow and speed of vehicles, further increase the use of electronic toll collection and contribute to safety, comfort and speed of travel.



The expansion of the Stara Pazova toll station involved the construction of 8 islands, resulting in a total of 17 traffic lanes, of which at least 3, at any time, are intended exclusively for users of electronic toll collection. Above the toll channels, a modernly equipped administrative building with an area of more than 300m² was built. The dimensions of the administrative building, erected 10 meters above the sidewalk of the traffic island, are



Promotion of the campaign "Drive fresh"

The Road Traffic Safety Agency, Traffic Police Directorate, PE "Roads of Serbia" and "EKO Serbia" presented on July 4, 2023 at a press conference, a campaign dedicated to increasing traffic safety - "Drive fresh".

The media were addressed by Acting Director of the Road Traffic Safety Agency Branko Stamatović, Head of the Traffic Police Directorate Slaviša Lakićević, Head of the Public Relations Department of PE "Roads of Serbia" Ljerka Ibrović and commercial director of "EKO Serbia" Nataša Vuksić.

The "Drive fresh" campaign aims to reduce the number of traffic accidents, especially those with serious injuries and fatalities, especially during the summer months when the intensity of traffic on the roads in Serbia is increased. Therefore, the importance of the joint performance



and support of the "Drive fresh" campaign, the natural partners in this task: the Road Traffic Safety Agency, the Traffic Police Directorate and PE "Roads of Serbia" is obvious.

Due to the importance of the campaign itself, PE "Roads of Serbia" as the manager of state roads, started on Tuesday, July 4, 2023, through the VMS portal, i.e. changeable traffic signals on the highway, to draw the attention of road users by displaying the slogan and the main message of the campaign - "Drive fresh!" Take a break every 2 hours".

- Toll station Indija (Installed power 20 kw)






Directors Drobniak and Antić guests of the show "Novo jutro" on TV Pink

Statehood Day celebration and supporting association "Always with children"


